## About IPT

Polytechnic Institute of Tomar is a relatively young institution. In 1973, it was created by ministerial decree, however, it was only possible to install the School of Technology in 1982. In 1986, the first bachelor's degree was created and classes were held in an old building located in the city center. Laboratories were scattered throughout the city. Finally, and at various points in 1992, the facilities were moved to the new Campus with an area of about 10 hectares. On January 1, 1997 it obtained the status of an independent polytechnic higher education establishment comprising 3 schools: the School of Management, the School of Technology of Tomar and the School of Technology of Abrantes. IPT has two campuses: the main campus in Tomar and the Abrantes Campus (in the city of Abrantes).

Currently, about 2600 members are part of our academic community: about 2300 are students and the rest are teaching, research, administrative and technical staff. The Tomar Campus is located in the city of Tomar and houses the Tomar School of Technology (ESTT) and the Tomar School of Management (ESGT) The Abrantes Campus is located in the city of Abrantes and houses the Abrantes School of Technology.
