Admission Requirements:

To be enrolled in a bachelor's degree, Integrated Master's Degree or master's degree in

the areas of Communication, Photography, Cinema and related areas. Preference will be

given to candidates with experience in the preparation of information and photographic

material, as well as to candidates who present good knowledge of the processes of science

communication and dissemination in the various media.

Work Plan

The fellows' work plan foresees the integration of the fellows in research and

Legislation and regulations applicable: Research Grant Holder Statute (Law no. 40/2004, of 18th August, in its current wording).

Workplace: The work will be carried out at the Higher Polytechnic Studies Centre of Mação of the Polytechnic Institute of Tomar under the scientific supervision of Professor Luiz Miguel Oosterbeek.

Duration of the scholarship(s): The fellowships will have a duration of 1 month, scheduled to begin on September 1st, 2022.

Amount of the monthly maintenance allowance: The amount of the grant corresponds to 486.12 euros according to the table of values of grants directly awarded by FCT, I.P. in Portugal (http://www.fct.pt/apoios/bolsas/valores).

Selection methods: The selection methods to be used will be as follows: curricular evaluation and interview, with the respective valuation up to a maximum of 3 (60%) and 2 (40%) values.

Composition of the Selection Committee: The Selection Committee will be composed of Professor Doctor Luiz Miguel Oosterbeek (President of the Jury), Doctor Sara Garcês (effective member), Doctor Hugo Gomes (effective member), Doctor Fernando Coimbra (alternate member), Doctor Pierluigi Rosina (alternate member).

Publication/Notification of results: The final results of the evaluation will be announced by means of a list sorted by final mark obtained posted in a visible and public place of the Polytechnic Institute of Tomar, and the approved candidate will be notified by e-mail.

Deadline for applications and how to submit applications: The call is open from 29-07-2022 to 15-08-2022. The deadline for submission of applications will be 5 working days after the publication of the announcement, considering the exceptional nature of the

support to be granted and the short duration of the grants, under the terms indicated by FCT.
