


a young and public university in the capital of Sweden



Our Research profile (2)

- Historical Studies
 - Archaeology, Ethnology, History, History of Ideas, and the Study of Religions
- Critical and Cultural Theory
 - The Theory of Practical Knowledge, Aesthetics,
 Philosophy, Gender Studies, Art History, Media and
 Communication Studies
- Environmental Studies
- Politics, Economy and the Organisation of Society
 - Business Administration, Sociology and Political Science
- Educational Science





Our internationalisation (1)

- 100 partners in Europe and about 30 partners outside of Europe, for example: Japan, South Korea, Taiwan, Mexico, Chile, Canada and USA
- Normally around 200 incoming international students per year
- Exchange students can study one semester or one full academic year
- Degree-seeking students study one or two years at master's level



Our internationalisation (2)


- We offer English-taught programmes:
 - Media, Communication and Cultural Analysis
 - English Literature
 - Social Science (Economics / Political Science / European Legal Studies / Journalism)
 - Leadership for Sustainable Development
 - Infectious Disease Control
 - Environmental Science
 - Tourism Studies
 - User Experience and Interactive Media Design



3. Swedish Higher Educational System

Academic system:

- Three-cycle system:
 - Undergraduate: 3 years/ 6 semesters
 * Professional degrees need 4-5 years
 - Graduate: 1-2 years/ 2-4 semesters
 - Doctoral studies: 4-5 years/ 8-10 semesters
- Semester:
 - Autumn semester: August January
 - Spring semester: January June
- Credits: 30 ECTS /semester
- Course schedule: Period system





3. Swedish Higher Educational System

Academic culture:

- Usually smaller classes and groups (20-40 students)
- Given reading/individual tasks
- An emphasis on discussion and group work
- Student-teacher relations are relatively informal
- Teachers are addressed by their first names






